Science

Plants

- To identify and describe the functions of different parts of flowering plants: roots, stem,/trunk, leaves and flowers.
- To explore the requirements of plants for life and growth (air, light, water, nutrients from the soil and room to grow) and how they vary from plant to plant.
- To investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.
- To explore the part that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.

<u>PE</u>

Netball:

- To be able to perform basic netball skills such as passing and catching using recognised throws.
