Task 5 – Spellings

Task 2 – English

This term, we are learning about writing for suspense. Create your own story using the techniques learnt.
Write a Spring acrostic poem.
Write a newspaper article about a current event.
Write a rap poem about Spring and perform it to music.
Keep a diary – use hyperbole, emotive language and rhetorical questions.

Task 3 – Maths

Use our current work on shape to draw, reflect and translate shapes on a four-quadrant grid.

Follow a recipe to make an item of food, carefully measuring the ingredients.

Plan a theme park, thinking about the prices of admission, the area required for the rides, amount of visitors per day, costs of maintenance. Show your work in a unique way.

Task 4 – Science

Make a boat that floats out of your recycling materials.

Sketch the flowers in the garden each day and watch how they change.

In the garden, draw your shadow at different times of the day and describe how it changes. Why does this happen?

Design an investigation that investigates friction on different surfaces using a toy car.

Task 5 – Spellings

Each day, learn some of your spellings using the previous list of words provided.

Task 1 – English
Interview an adult. Ask them about their life and write an autobiography. You can write it using Purple Mash or it can be handwritten.

Encourage children to ask good questions, identifying the key information and recording notes using bullet points.

Task 2 – English
This term we are learning about writing and performing playscripts. Choose a story that you know and like and rewrite at least one scene as a playscript. Make sure you make it clear who is saying which lines by including character names on the left and add stage directions to help set the scene and tell the actors how to act.

Task 3 – Maths
Create your own Times Table board game linked to the 6, 7 and 8 times table.

Task 4 – Maths
Look at prices on a receipt. Find different combinations of coins that you could use to pay. What change would you receive from £5, £10, £20?

Task 5 - Science
Research the Water Cycle and the three main processes – precipitation, evaporation, condensation. Watch this video <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Oq8iCsV4woE> and look online for more information then create a poster, song or poem to teach someone else in your family all about it.

Task 9 – Outdoor Learning

Once baked, cut into eight equal pieces. Create and describe different fractions. Discuss how different fractions can show the same quantity. Enjoy! Yum,

Listen to you favourite songs. Identify the instruments that you can hear.

Encourage children to concentrate on the music and the sounds made by different instruments. Use effective adjectives to describe the sounds. Discuss the tempo/rhythm.
