Don Rae, an experienced performing arts teacher, will be back to teach the children dances which they will perform after school. The children will also be learning, History, Geography and RE relating to their countries during the day.

We ask that children **dress-up** to represent the country their year group has been allocated. They may wear National Costume or wear the colours of the countries' flag.

We would love for families to join in with our international experience too. It would be great if parents, grandparents and siblings could join us from pickup and go to the school hall via the KS1 entrance. Our showcase will **start at 3:30pm** in the hall to watch the dances and then from **4:15-5.00pm** we will share food from around the world together. In order to **share different foods**, we are asking if you could bring in a national dish from your country of origin or a traditional dish or snack that you enjoy! The PTA will be collecting food in the morning at drop off and food can also be brought at pick up. Food will be served in the Dining Hall.

**Important: we are a nut free school so no products with nuts are allowed and we also have pupils with other allergies so we would appreciate you clearly labelling food with all ingredients. Thank you.**
