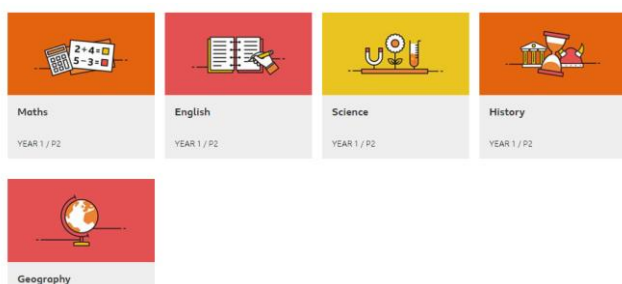
There is a range of subjects to choose from. Do not worry if this may differ from what is being taught in school. This is an excellent source of on-line learning for our pupils.
